Ordnance Survey on August 26, 1870, the elevation was found to be 73.7 feet above sea-level. The boatman stated that the water may rise 2 feet above its level on September 20, 1902, and fall 3 feet lower, giving a range of 5 feet. Temperature observations gave $50^{\circ}.5$ at the surface, and $50^{\circ}.1$ at a depth of 7 feet.
