the same level during the nine days spent in surveying it. The average height of the water for the whole of the year is about $1\frac{1}{2}$ feet above the level on July 16, 1902; the water has been known to rise 9 feet higher and to fall 1 foot lower than the level on this date.




FIG. 37.—INDEX MAP OF THE EWE BASIN.
