Temperature Observations.-The following serial temperatures were taken at 3 p.m. on July 8, 1902, in the deepest part of Loch Dilate :-


This series shows a constant temperature from the surface down to a depth of 20 feet, a slight fall of $0^{\circ} \cdot 8$ between 20 and 25 feet, then a very rapıd fall of $6^{\circ} .2$ between 25 and 30 feet (a fall exceedıng $1^{\circ}$ per foot of depth), and a further fall of $2^{\circ}$ between 30 and 50 feet, the extreme range of temperature being $9^{\circ}$ Fahr.
