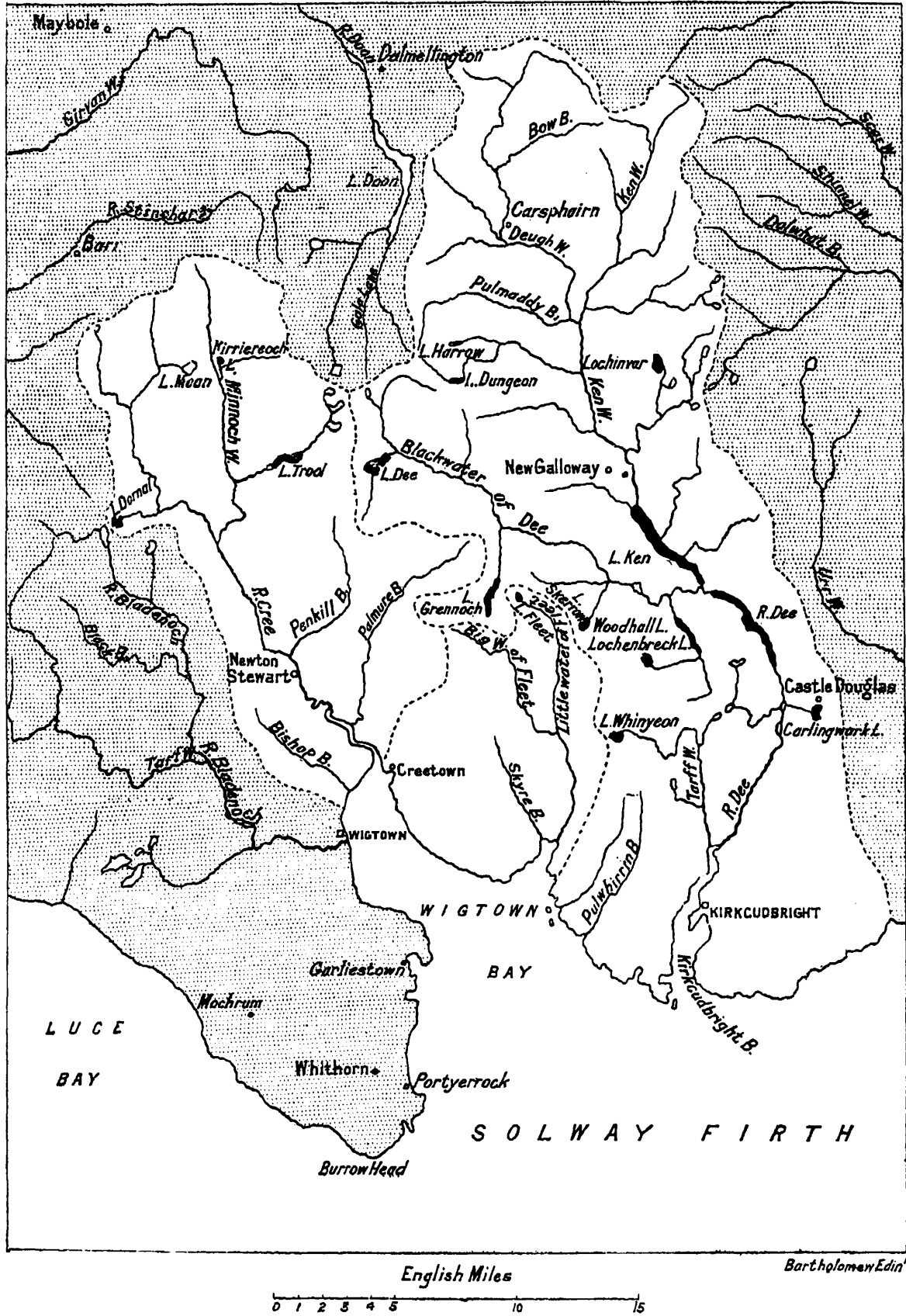


FIG. 12.—INDEX MAP OF THE CREE, FLEET, AND DEE BASINS.
