quite fresh. It trends in a south-west and north-east direction, and is twothirds of a mile in length, by a quarter of a mile in maximum breadth, covering an area of about 60 acres. The loch is very shallow, 93 per cent. of the lake-floor being covered by less than 5 feet of water, and the south-west end is filled with weeds. The maximum depth of 6 feet was observed in two places, the mean depth being estimated at $2\frac{3}{4}$ feet, and the volume of water at 7 million cubic feet. The drainage area is about 3 square miles. On May 25, 1904, the surface temperature was $58^{\circ} \cdot 0$ Fahr.
